deal with prosecutors. He faces one to 10 years in prison.

Burke had been in a years-long relationship with Alexander's older sister, TyQuanda, but the two were in the process of breaking up, prosecutor Shavaughn Banks wrote in a court document signed by Burke.

TyQuanda thought Burke owed her money, so Burke's sister told her to come over to his house in the 1300 block of Olinger St., Banks wrote. She went with her mother, LaDawn, and younger brother, Ke'Shawn.

When the three of them got there, TyQuanda went to talk to Burke, Banks added. The two got into an argument in front of the house, so LaDawn got out of the car to try and calm things down. But, as she approached the couple, a black car pulled up. Two women got out and attacked TyQuanda.

Ke'Shawn Alexander got out of the car to protect his sister and break up the fight, Banks wrote. As he tried to do so, Burke flashed a handgun and then fired it.
